Directions To NASA Armstrong Bldg. 703 in Palmdale

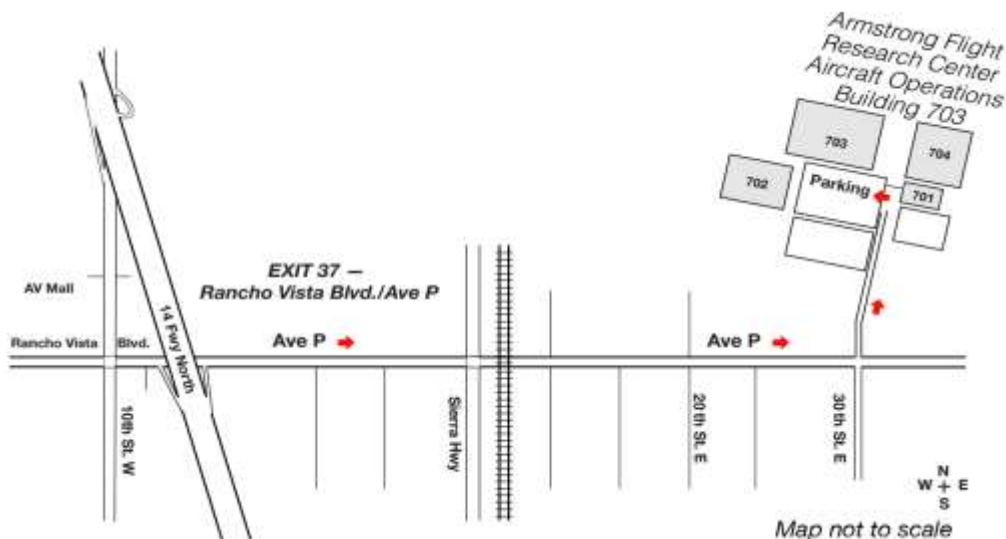
FROM LOS ANGELES: Interstate highways 405 (San Diego Freeway) or 5 (Golden State Freeway) to State Highway 14 (Antelope Valley Freeway) to Palmdale. Turn off at the Rancho Vista Boulevard (Avenue P) exit, turn east (right). Proceed east on Rancho Vista Boulevard approximately four miles to 30th Street East. Turn left onto the entrance road and proceed about a half-mile into the complex, turn left into the parking lot for the NASA Armstrong facility in Bldg. 703. The main entrance is roughly at the mid-point on the south side of the building, just behind the visitor control station.

FROM RENO/BISHOP: Highway 395 southbound to Highway 14 southbound to Palmdale, take the 10th Street West off-ramp, turn left at Rancho Vista Boulevard (Avenue P) about 200 yards south, proceed eastbound and follow directions as above. Travel time is about 3 ½ hours from Bishop, 7 ½ hours from Reno.

FROM PALMDALE/LANCASTER: Highway 14 (Antelope Valley Freeway) or Sierra Highway to Rancho Vista Boulevard (Avenue P), follow directions as above.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO/SACRAMENTO/FRESNO/BAKERSFIELD: Interstate 5 or Highway 99 to Bakersfield, then take Highway 58 east to Mojave exit, turn south on Highway 14 to Palmdale, exit at 10th Street West, turn left a Rancho Vista Boulevard (Avenue P), follow directions as above. Travel time is about two hours from Bakersfield, four hours from Fresno, seven hours from San Francisco/Sacramento.

VISITOR ACCESS: After parking, please proceed to the visitor control station on the north edge of the parking lot to meet your escort and obtain your visitor's badge.
